

2020 District 5 Shooting Sports Rifle Information

Date

Saturday, April 25, 2020

Location

Trinity County Fairgrounds (at the junction of Hwy 94 and 287),
 2694 Highway 287, Groveton, Texas

Entry Requirements

- Enter individually on 4-H Connect beginning February 26, 2020 at <https://texas.4honline.com>
- Contest Fee – \$10 per contestant
 - ✓ **Rifle** (Individual or Team event) – When registering as a team, all members must be listed in 4-H Connect.
- Late Entry Fee - \$25 per contestant

District Deadlines

- Registration on 4-H Connect by **April 8, 2020 and approved at the county level.**
- Soft due date for agents: **April 9, 2020** (only to be used for corrections to entries)
- Late entry – **April 10-13, 2020** (late fees apply)

Entry Divisions (grade by August 31, 2019)

- Junior Grades 3, 4, and 5
- Intermediate Grades 6, 7, and 8
- Senior Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12

Events

- Junior Prone
- Intermediate Prone, Standing and Kneeling
- Senior Prone, Standing and Kneeling

Tentative Schedule

- Schedule may be modified based upon number of contestants.
- Specific times for each event will be sent to county agents ONE week before event.
- Safety orientation will begin at 7:30 a.m.
- Events will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m.

Special Accommodations

- Any competitor who requires auxiliary aids or special accommodations must contact the District office at least 2 weeks before the competition or note such needs when registering on 4-H Connect.

District 5 Rifle Games Contestant Rules

Rifle (individual or team entry)

Entry

- Enter as an individual or a team that is comprised of 3 to 4 members of the same 4-H age division.

Equipment

- Each competitor must provide their own ear and eye protection and ammunition.
- Smallbore rifles (.22 caliber) must be used.
- Targets will be provided.

Contest

- No use of a platform, sandbag or any other type of rest for Prone position competition. A sling is recommended for stability.
- Rifles brought to the range must be unloaded with bolts open.
- When moving to the line, all rifles must have bolts open with an empty chamber indicator/open bolt indicator in place.
- Disorderly, unsafe or abusive conduct will not be allowed. This type of conduct may lead to disqualification.
- The match director will have final say in all disputes.

Time Limits

- Each team is permitted one hour to complete their practice and competition shots.

Awards

- Team awards for 1st – 3rd places in each age division will be presented.
- High point team award for each position in each age division will be presented.
- Overall individual high point award will be presented.

Qualifying for State Rifle Tournament

- The top three Senior age division teams (grades 9-12) at the District-level Rifle contest will advance to state.
