District 5 Event Guidelines

Entry Requirements

- Enter individually on 4HOnline beginning March 8, 2021 at <https://texas.v2.4honline.com>
- Contest Fee - \$20 per contestant (or bow)
- (Individual event). Late Entry Fee - \$25 per contestant

District Deadlines

- Registration on 4HOnline and county approval by **April 1, 2021**
- Soft due date for agents: **April 2, 2021** (only to be used for corrections to entries)
- Late entry – **April 3-6, 2021** (late fees apply)

Entry Divisions (grade by August 31, 2020)

- Junior Grades 3, 4, and 5
- Intermediate Grades 6, 7, and 8
- Senior Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12

Adult Contest Participation

- District 5 adults (parents, volunteers, and agents) that have a 4-H profile in 4HOnline can show off their archery skills.
- Same entrance requirements as 4-H youth (see above).
- Show off your archery skills for District 5 “bragging rights!”

Entries Per County

- Number of individuals per age division submitted from county is unlimited.

Special Accommodations

- Any competitor who requires auxiliary aids or special accommodations must contact the District office at least 2 weeks before the competition or note such needs when registering on 4HOnline.

Awards

- Presentation of awards for each event will be held following tabulation of results.
- Individual awards for 1st – 3rd places in each age division will be presented.
- Overall individual high point award will be presented both youth and adult participant.
- Entry via 4HOnline gives permission to the District office to use the participant’s name and/or photograph as needed for marketing and promotion purposes.
