What's New?

We are excited for the Summer of 2025 as we have many new opportunities to offer you and your family! Some things to note:

- We still have fishing and STEM camp!
 - Fishing and STEM camp have been added as tracks to our Horizons Camp. The programming will remain the same as previous years.
- Due to parent and camper feedback some of our camp lengths have changed
 - Some of our camps have gone from four days to five days. We have also added a few mini camps as well.
- We have added an adventure camp and a District Camp - be sure to check them out!
- Grade range for camps have changed
 - All camps are now grades 3 8. Grade is determined by September 2024.
 - Due to age requirement for Testing, Camper must be 9 years old for Horizons Hunter's Education
